## 2023-2024 Bradley Arts Grant Awardees

For 40 years, since the inception of the West Contra Costa Public Education Fund in 1983, providing resources to our teachers and students in the classroom has remained a central focus of our organization. That is why we are pleased to announce that the Ed Fund proudly awarded over \$36,000 this year in Arts grants from our Brad Bradley Bequest, with support from our donors, for 46 classroom and school-wide projects, as well as community events across our district. Grants ranged from \$500 to \$1,500.

These projects empower teachers and students with programming that centers their voice and utilizes the Arts as a tool to disrupt the historical inequalities within our public education system. The Ed Fund would like to recognize the additional impact that many of these projects will have on African American/Black students by centering art/artists from their backgrounds.
